Motorcycle Roadworthy & Safety Checklist



	Check item	What to check	Pass
1	Type of bike	Unless you are doing an open class course, your motorcycle must be LAMS approved. Please note if you have modified your LAMS motorcycle it may no longer be approved or legal for use as a LAM.	
2	Tyres	Tread depth is legal, sidewalls not damaged and inflated correctly. If you're on a dirt bike, your tyres must be legal to use on the road.	
3	Electrics	All lights, indicators and horn working correctly. Kill switch works and turns the engine off. All light covers are unbroken and intact, with no white light showing from the indicators or tail light.	
4	Chain and chain guard	Chain must be in good condition and tensioned correctly. The motorcycle must be fitted with a chain guard	
5	Mirrors	Two mirrors must be fitted, without cracks.	
6	Throttle	The throttle must operate smoothly and snap back to zero throttle when released	
7	Levers	All levers (clutch, brake and gear) must be intact, unbroken and function correctly	
8	L or P plate	A learner plate must be fitted correctly and match your licence class	
9	Suspension	No oil leaks from suspension	
10	Engine and exhaust	No excessive oil leaking from the engine and the exhaust is not too loud or blowing excessive smoke.	
11	Throttle grip	When releasing the throttle, it must "snap" back to zero throttle immediately	
12	Registration and number plate	The motorcycle must be currently registered and the number plate must be displayed in accordance with the road rules.
